

Palladino, Barolo Serralunga 2019

For Alessandro Olocco, head of the internal market at Palladino, 'the 2019 is a warm vintage which remembers the 2015 with the drinkability of 2013.' This Comune di Serralunga d'Alba 2019 is a gem of balance. The nose opens up with wet-earth minerality, restrained cherry kernel, rhubarb root and blood orange. The attack is lifted and refreshing, with ripe, well extracted tannins. Chiselled contemporary Barolo.
