

Palladino, San Bernardo Riserva Barolo 2015

Drinking Window: 2021 – 2040

Imagine an inverted 'L' looking at the San Bernardo MGA within Serralunga: Palladino owns this part of the cru, which is the highest but also turns towards the south. This exposure in what could be considered a cooler flank of the village brings special complexity to this wine. Bright ruby with a brick rim, leathery notes over wild berries and bitter orange are suggestive of the complexity expressed by San Bernardo. The palate is crisp with refined, sweet tannins. It's tight yet not austere, warming at the end. Very classic; a brighter expression of Serralunga.
