

Palladino San Bernardo Riserva 2013

Palladino owns a fine set of vineyards in Serralunga, and as the small San Bernardo cru tends to produce the most tannic wines, it is now the source of its Riserva. The nose is quite perfumed, displaying ripe red fruits. Although very concentrated, it's not monolithic on the palate, with polished tannins and considerable vigour. The balance seems impeccable and the length impressive. It could be approached now, but should unfurl beautifully in a few years.
